PARTS OF SPEECH

STRUCTURE OF LANGUAGE

1ST

FUNCTION OF WORDS

The purpose of this work is to provide the child with the parts of speech and to associate a grammar symbol with that part of speech.

ORAL GAMES

This work introduces and illustrates the various structures of complete sentences.

READING ANALYSIS 1

This work introduces diagnostic questions to determine sentence structure and emphasizes the function of words in a sentence.

2ND

GRAMMAR COMMAND CARDS

This work serves as a bridge connecting Function of Words to Grammar Boxes. The purpose here is to clarify the meanings of words and often to suggest a practical interpretation of them.

SENTENCE CONSTRUCTION 1

This work guides the writing process and emphasizes the sentence structures covered so far.

GRAMMAR BOXES

This work allows the child to more closely analyze the parts of speech and their purpose in giving meaning to language.

READING ANALYSIS 2

This work introduces more complex diagnostic questions to determine sentence structure, including adverbials and indirect objects.

3RD

DEVELOPING WRITING THROUGH GRAMMAR

This work moves students toward abstraction and emphasizes varied strategies to convey meaning through written language.

SENTENCE CONSTRUCTION 2

This work emphasizes the use and placement of adverbials and indirect objects within a sentence.

LOGICAL ANALYSIS 1 & 2

This work introduces the vocabulary to accurately name the individual sentence elements.
