

Tug-O-War

This game for two players indirectly prepares children for number lines, addition and subtraction. The game is played by:

1. Placing the game marker on the start circle.
2. Each player takes an "end" to move the game marker toward and eventually off of the mat.
3. The first player rolls the die and moves the marker toward his end of the mat. For example, if the player rolls a three, and he is sitting on the right hand side of the mat, he will move the marker three spaces to the right.
4. The second player rolls the die and moves the marker to the left the number shown on the die.
5. The first player to move the marker off of the mat is the winner.
